Section 4503(a) of Title 42 of the Pennsylvania 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding paragraphs to read: § 4503. Exemptions from jury duty. 8 9 General rule. -- No person shall be exempt or excused from jury duty except the following: 10 11 12 (6) Parents or quardians who have custody of a child under seven years of age, who are the primary caregivers of 13 14 the child and who opt not to serve. 15 (7) Parents or quardians who have custody of a school-16 age child who has been excused from compulsory attendance at

school or a special education program, who provide

- instruction for the child and who opt not to serve.
- 2 (8) Persons who are primary caregivers of an elderly or
- 3 <u>disabled family member and who opt not to serve.</u>

- 5 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
