AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), entitled "An
 - act to consolidate, editorially revise, and codify the public
- welfare laws of the Commonwealth," in public assistance,
- 4 providing for the establishment of KEYS.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. The act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), known
- 8 as the Public Welfare Code, is amended by adding a section to
- 9 read:
- 10 <u>Section 405.1B. Establishment of KEYS.--(a) There is</u>
- 11 established in the department a program which shall be known as
- 12 Keystone Education Yields Success (KEYS). KEYS shall be designed
- 13 to enable and to assist individuals receiving TANF or SNAP
- 14 benefits to enroll in and pursue a certificate or degree program
- 15 <u>within one of the Commonwealth's community colleges OR</u>
- 16 UNIVERSITY WITHIN THE PENNSYLVANIA STATE SYSTEM OF HIGHER

- 1 EDUCATION.
- 2 (b) A KEYS recipient shall be permitted to count vocational
- 3 education, including class time, clinicals, labs and study time
- 4 as set by the community college, toward the recipient's core
- 5 TANF work requirement for twenty-four months.
- 6 (c) In accordance with KEYS and notwithstanding section
- 7 405.1, the following requirements shall apply:
- 8 (1) A recipient shall be enrolled in a degree or
- 9 <u>certificate program that will assist the recipient in</u>
- 10 securing a job that pays a family-sustaining wage.
- 11 (2) A KEYS recipient may be granted a six-month
- 12 <u>extension to complete the certificate or degree program,</u>
- 13 provided:
- (i) the recipient is enrolled in a program that will
- 15 <u>lead to a high-priority occupation, as defined in section</u>
- 16 <u>1301 of the act of December 18, 2001 (P.L.949, No.114),</u>
- 17 known as the Workforce Development Act or a program the
- 18 community college has certified meets the same criteria
- as a high-priority occupation;
- 20 <u>(ii) The recipient has maintained a 2.0 grade point</u>
- 21 average; and
- 22 (iii) the recipient has made satisfactory progress
- 23 toward completing the program, including, but not limited
- to, completing all required developmental course work and
- 25 successfully completing an average of eight credits per
- semester.
- 27 (d) A person who, without good cause, fails or refuses to
- 28 comply with the terms and conditions of the KEYS program shall
- 29 be terminated from the program.
- 30 (e) The department shall promulgate regulations to implement

- 1 <u>this section.</u>
- 2 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
