AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial 3 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the 4 laws relating thereto," in reimbursements by Commonwealth and 5 between school districts, establishing the Emergency Basic 6 Education Subsidy Fund; and providing for basic education subsidy continuation funding. 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 10 hereby enacts as follows: 11 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known 12 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a 13 section to read: 14 Section 2599.6. Emergency Basic Education Subsidy Fund. -- (a) 15 The Emergency Basic Education Subsidy Fund is established as a 16 separate fund in the State Treasury. The money of the fund is appropriated on a continuing basis to carry out the provisions 17 18 of this section.
- 19 (b) If legislation providing an appropriation for the basic

- 1 <u>education subsidy is not enacted by August 15, the State</u>
- 2 Treasurer shall periodically transfer unappropriated,
- 3 unrestricted General Fund money, to the extent that the funds
- 4 are available, to the Emergency Basic Education Subsidy Fund.
- 5 The transfers shall be up to the dollar amounts and at the times
- 6 <u>as necessary to meet the requirements of section 2517(c).</u>
- 7 (c) If the Governor fails to certify revenue estimates under
- 8 <u>section 618 of the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), known</u>
- 9 as "The Administrative Code of 1929," for the current fiscal
- 10 year the Secretary of Revenue shall certify to the State
- 11 <u>Treasurer each time a transfer is needed under subsection (a)</u>
- 12 that there is adequate unappropriated, unrestricted General Fund
- 13 money to make the transfer.
- 14 (d) (1) The Secretary of Education shall draw a warrant on
- 15 the State Treasurer in favor of each district for the amount to
- 16 which the district is entitled, to meet each basic education
- 17 subsidy payment to the school districts pursuant to the payment
- 18 schedule under section 2517(c).
- 19 (2) Payments made to each school district shall be in the
- 20 same amount as provided in the previous year.
- 21 (e) Transfers provided under this section shall only be in
- 22 effect during the time in which no basic education subsidy
- 23 appropriation has been enacted and shall be made only in the
- 24 amount necessary to meet each basic education subsidy payment to
- 25 the school districts pursuant to the payment schedule under
- 26 section 2517(c).
- 27 (f) Notwithstanding any other provisions of this act, the
- 28 board of school directors of each school district may reopen the
- 29 board's budget to reflect funding provided under this section.
- 30 Section 2. This act shall apply to fiscal years beginning

- 1 after June 30, 2015.
- 2 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
