12	Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known

16	The Emergency Basic Education Subsidy Fund is established as a
17	separate fund in the State Treasury. The money of the fund is
18	appropriated on a continuing basis to carry out the provisions <
19	of this section.

3	subsidy APPROPRIATION is not enacted by August 15, the State <
4	Treasurer shall periodically transfer unappropriated,

6	are available, OF ANY FISCAL YEAR, FUNDS ARE HEREBY APPROPRIATED <
7	TO THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF EMERGENCY
8	BASIC EDUCATION FUNDING. TO THE EXTENT SUCH FUNDS ARE AVAILABLE,
9	THE STATE TREASURER SHALL TRANSFER SUCH FUNDS to the Emergency
