AN ACT

Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 1 Statutes, in other required equipment, further providing for 2 television equipment. 3 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 5 hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. Section 4527 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read: 8 § 4527. [Television] Video receiving equipment. <--9 (a) General rule. [No] Except as provided in subsection 10 (b), no person shall drive a motor vehicle [operated on a 11 highway shall be] equipped with [television type] any image_ 12 display device, video receiving equipment, including a 13 a video monitor or a television or video screen 14 displaying a television broadcast, 15 entertainment or business applications 16 which is located in the motor vehicle at any point forward of 17 the back of the driver's seat [or otherwise] or which is

2	(a.1) Installation of device prohibited. Except as provided
3	in subsection (b), no person may install in a motor vehicle an
4	image display device intended to be visible to a driver in the
5	normal driving position when the vehicle is in motion and the
6	driver is restrained by the safety seat belt system adjusted in
7	accordance with the manufacturer's recommendations.
8	(b) Exception. This section shall not apply to the
9	following:
10	(1) [Television type receiving equipment] Image display
11	devices in a vehicle used exclusively for safety or law-
12	enforcement purposes as approved by the Pennsylvania State
13	Police.
14	(2) [Electronic displays] Image display devices used in
15	conjunction with in-vehicle navigation systems[.] or to
16	display related traffic, road and weather information.
17	(3) Image display devices that provide vehicle
18	information related to the driving task or to enhance or
19	supplement the driver's view forward, behind or to the sides
20	of the vehicle or permit the driver to monitor vehicle
21	occupants behind the driver.
22	(4) Image display devices that do not display a
23	broadcast television image or a moving visual image, other
24	than text, from a digital video disk or other storage device
25	to the driver while the vehicle is in motion.
26	(5) Image display devices which display an image while a
27	vehicle is parked.
28	(c) Definition. As used in this section, the term "image

5	(A) GENERAL RULE NO MOTOR VEHICLE SHALL BE OPERATED ON A
6	HIGHWAY [SHALL BE EQUIPPED] WITH [TELEVISION-TYPE RECEIVING
7	EQUIPMENT FORWARD OF THE BACK OF THE DRIVER'S SEAT OR OTHERWISE]
8	AN IMAGE DISPLAY DEVICE WHERE A BROADCAST TELEVISION IMAGE, A
9	LIVE STREAM VIDEO IMAGE FROM THE INTERNET, SATELLITE OR ANY
10	OTHER SOURCE OR A PRERECORDED VIDEO IMAGE IS VISIBLE TO THE
11	DRIVER WHILE THE VEHICLE IS IN MOTION.
12	(B) EXCEPTIONTHIS SECTION SHALL NOT APPLY TO THE
13	FOLLOWING:
14	(1) TELEVISION-TYPE RECEIVING EQUIPMENT IN A VEHICLE
15	USED EXCLUSIVELY FOR SAFETY OR LAW ENFORCEMENT PURPOSES AS
16	APPROVED BY THE PENNSYLVANIA STATE POLICE.
17	(2) [ELECTRONIC DISPLAYS] <u>IMAGE DISPLAY DEVICES</u> USED IN
18	CONJUNCTION WITH [IN-VEHICLE NAVIGATION SYSTEMS.] ANY OF THE
19	FOLLOWING:
20	(I) A VEHICLE INFORMATION DISPLAY.
21	(II) A GLOBAL POSITIONING DEVICE.
22	(III) A MAPPING DISPLAY.
23	(IV) A VISUAL DISPLAY USED TO ENHANCE OR SUPPLEMENT
24	THE DRIVER'S VIEW FORWARD, BEHIND OR TO THE SIDES OF A
25	MOTOR VEHICLE FOR THE PURPOSE OF MANEUVERING THE VEHICLE.
26	(V) A VISUAL DISPLAY USED TO ENHANCE OR SUPPLEMENT A
27	DRIVER'S VIEW OF VEHICLE OCCUPANTS.
28	(VI) A VISUAL DISPLAY USED EXCLUSIVELY FOR SAFETY OR
29	TRAFFIC ENGINEERING INFORMATION.
30	(VII) A TELEVISION RECEIVER, VIDEO MONITOR,

1	TELEVISION OR VIDEO SCREEN OR ANY OTHER SIMILAR MEANS OF
2	VISUALLY DISPLAYING A TELEVISION BROADCAST OR VIDEO
3	SIGNAL, IF THAT EQUIPMENT HAS AN INTERLOCK DEVICE THAT,
4	WHEN THE MOTOR VEHICLE IS DRIVEN, DISABLES THE EQUIPMENT
5	FROM DISPLAYING A BROADCAST TELEVISION IMAGE, LIVE STREAM
6	VIDEO IMAGE FROM THE INTERNET, SATELLITE OR ANY OTHER
7	SOURCE, OR A PRERECORDED VIDEO IMAGE.
8	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
