AN ACT

Amending the act of March 4, 1971 (P.L.6, No.2), entitled "An act relating to tax reform and State taxation by codifying 2 and enumerating certain subjects of taxation and imposing 3 taxes thereon; providing procedures for the payment, collection, administration and enforcement thereof; providing for tax credits in certain cases; conferring powers and 6 imposing duties upon the Department of Revenue, certain employers, fiduciaries, individuals, persons, corporations 8 and other entities; prescribing crimes, offenses and 9 penalties," in personal income tax, providing for 10 contributions for the School District Contributions Fund. 11 12 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 13 hereby enacts as follows: 14 Section 1. The act of March 4, 1971 (P.L.6, No.2), known as 15 the Tax Reform Code of 1971, is amended by adding a section to 16 read: Section 315.12. Contributions for the School District 17 Contributions Fund. -- (a) Beginning with taxable years ending 18 19 after December 31, 2014, the department shall provide a space on 20 the Pennsylvania individual income tax return form whereby an 21 individual may designate a contribution to any public school district in this Commonwealth. Contributions may be in an amount 22

- 1 of not less than one dollar (\$1).
- 2 (b) The amount designated under subsection (a) by an
- 3 individual on the income tax return form shall be deducted from
- 4 the tax refund to which the individual is entitled and shall not
- 5 constitute a charge against the income tax revenues due to the
- 6 <u>Commonwealth</u>.
- 7 (c) The department shall determine annually the total amount
- 8 <u>designated under this section, less reasonable administrative</u>
- 9 costs, and shall report the amount to the State Treasurer, who
- 10 shall transfer the amount to a restricted revenue account within
- 11 the General Fund to be used for contributions to the School
- 12 <u>District Contribution Fund as provided by statute.</u>
- 13 (d) The department shall provide adequate information
- 14 concerning the checkoff in its instructions which accompany the
- 15 Pennsylvania income tax return forms. The information concerning
- 16 the checkoff shall include the listing of an address to which
- 17 contributions may be sent by taxpayers wishing to contribute to
- 18 this effort but who do not receive refunds.
- 19 (e) The department shall report annually to the respective
- 20 committees of the Senate and the House of Representatives which
- 21 <u>have jurisdiction over public education funding on the amount</u>
- 22 received via checkoff contributions by each public school
- 23 district in the prior year.
- 24 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
