AN ACT

Amending the act of May 13, 2015 (P.L.14, No.3), entitled, "An act designating the interchange of State Route 43 at the Mon-2 Fayette Expressway Interchange with State Route 88, known as 3 Exit 28, in Washington County as the Marine Cpl. Thomas R. 4 Matty Memorial Interchange; designating a bridge on that portion of State Route 1013, known as Knupp Road, over the 5 6 7 Hypocrite Creek, Fairfield Township, Westmoreland County, as the PFC LeRoy D. "Whitey" Schaller Bridge; designating a 8 portion of State Route 711 in New Florence Borough through 9 St. Clair Township, Westmoreland County, as the Veterans 10 Highway; designating a bridge on that portion of State Route 11 88 over Muddy Creek, Cumberland Township, Greene County, as 12 the Army Corporal Richard W. Kowalewski, Jr., Memorial 13 Bridge; designating the bridge carrying U.S. Route 322 over 14 15 the east branch of the Brandywine Creek in West Bradford and East Caln Townships, Chester County, as the Robbie and Ryan 16 Miller Memorial Bridge; designating the bridge located on 17 18 State Route 34 that connects the banks of the Juniata River in Newport, Perry County, as the Paul Reider bridge; and designating a portion of State Route 2029 and 2049, also known as Bath Road, in Bristol Township, Bucks County, as the Sergeant George Stuckey Memorial Road," further providing for 19 20 21 22 the Army Corporal Richard W. Kowalewski, Jr., Memorial 23 Bridge. 24

- 25 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 26 hereby enacts as follows:
- 27 The title of the act of May 13, 2015 (P.L.14, Section 1.

- 7 Township, Westmoreland County, as the Veterans Highway;
- 8 designating a bridge on that portion of State Route 88 over
- 9 Muddy Creek, Cumberland Township, Greene County, as the Army
- 10 Corporal Richard W. Kowalewski, Jr., Memorial Bridge;
- 11 designating the bridge carrying U.S. Route 322 over the east
- 12 branch of the Brandywine Creek in West Bradford and East Caln
- 13 Townships, Chester County, as the Robbie and Ryan Miller
- 14 Memorial Bridge; designating the bridge located on State Route
- 15 34 that connects the banks of the Juniata River in Newport,
- 16 Perry County, as the Paul Reider bridge; and designating a
- 17 portion of State Route 2029 and 2049, also known as Bath Road,
- 18 in Bristol Township, Bucks County, as the Sergeant George
- 19 Stuckey Memorial Road," is amended to read:
- 20 An Act
- 21 Designating the interchange of State Route 43 at the Mon-Fayette
- 22 Expressway Interchange with State Route 88, known as Exit 28,
- 23 in Washington County as the Marine Cpl. Thomas R. Matty
- Memorial Interchange; designating a bridge on that portion of

- Bridge; designating the bridge carrying U.S. Route 322 over
- 4 the east branch of the Brandywine Creek in West Bradford and
- 5 East Caln Townships, Chester County, as the Robbie and Ryan
- 6 Miller Memorial Bridge; designating the bridge located on
- 7 State Route 34 that connects the banks of the Juniata River
- 8 in Newport, Perry County, as the Paul Reider bridge; and
- 9 designating a portion of State Route 2029 and 2049, also
- 10 known as Bath Road, in Bristol Township, Bucks County, as the
- 11 Sergeant George Stuckey Memorial Road.
- 12 Section 2. Section 4 of the act is amended to read:
- 13 Section 4. Army [Corporal] Specialist Richard W. Kowalewski,
- Jr., Memorial Bridge.
- 15 (a) Findings. -- The General Assembly finds and declares as
- 16 follows:
- 17 (1) Richard W. Kowalewski, Jr., was born on March 31,
- 18 1973, in Waynesburg, Pennsylvania.
- 19 (2) Richard W. Kowalewski, Jr., enlisted in the United
- 20 States Army and completed basic training in June 1992.
- 21 (3) [Corporal] <u>Specialist</u> Kowalewski was later assigned
- to the 3rd Battalion, 75th Ranger Regiment.
- 23 (4) As part of a United Nations peace keeping operation,
- [Corporal] Specialist Kowalewski was deployed to Somalia in
- 25 August 1993.
- 26 (5) On October 3, 1993, [Corporal] <u>Specialist</u>
- 27 Kowalewski, along with 17 other men, were killed in the
- 28 Battle of Mogadishu. During the battle, a group of Somalis,
- armed with automatic weapons and rocket-propelled grenades,
- 30 ambushed [Corporal] <u>Specialist</u> Kowalewski's convoy while in

- 1 route to rescue downed pilots of a Black Hawk helicopter.
- 2 (6) The encounter has been described as one of our
- 3 country's most violent firefights since Vietnam. The battle
- 4 was later depicted in the famous novel and movie "Black Hawk
- 5 Down."
- 6 (7) For his heroic actions during battle, [Corporal]
- 7 Specialist Kowalewski was awarded the Bronze Star Medal with
- 8 Valor and the Purple Heart.
- 9 (b) Designation.--The Bridge located on State Route 88 in
- 10 Cumberland Township, Greene County, Section Q10, Segment
- 11 0300/0000, Structure Number S-31843, over Muddy Creek is hereby
- 12 designated the Army [Corporal] <u>Specialist</u> Richard W. Kowalewski,
- 13 Jr., Memorial Bridge.
- 14 (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and
- 15 maintain appropriate signs which shall display the name of the
- 16 bridge designated in subsection (b).
- 17 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
