AN ACT

- Amending Title 62 (Procurement) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in Iran-free procurement, further providing for
- 3 expiration.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 3506 of Title 62 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 3506. Expiration.
- 9 The department shall have no obligations under this chapter
- 10 with respect to a company engaged in business activities in Iran
- 11 [upon the occurrence of any of the following:
- 12 (1) Iran does not appear on the List of State Sponsors
- 13 of Terrorism.
- 14 (2) The President or Congress of the United States,
- 15 through legislation or executive order, declares that
- 16 mandatory divestment of the type provided for in this chapter
- interferes with the conduct of United States foreign policy.]

- 1 upon the repeal of the Comprehensive Iran Sanctions,
- 2 Accountability, and Divestment Act of 2010 (Public Law 111-
- 3 195, 124 Stat. 1312) by the Congress of the United States.
- 4 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
