AN ACT

1 Amending Title 62 (Procurement) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated  
2 Statutes, in Iran-free procurement, further providing for  
3 expiration.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Section 3506 of Title 62 of the Pennsylvania  
7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:

8 § 3506. Expiration.

9 The department shall have no obligations under this chapter  
10 with respect to a company engaged in business activities in Iran  
11 [upon the occurrence of any of the following:

12 (1) Iran does not appear on the List of State Sponsors  
13 of Terrorism.

14 (2) The President or Congress of the United States,  
15 through legislation or executive order, declares that  
16 mandatory divestment of the type provided for in this chapter  
17 interferes with the conduct of United States foreign policy.]

1     upon the repeal of the Comprehensive Iran Sanctions,  
2     Accountability, and Divestment Act of 2010 (Public Law 111-  
3     195, 124 Stat. 1312) by the Congress of the United States.  
4     Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
