- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
- 10 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a
- 11 section to read:
- 12 Section 1613.1. Graduation Requirement. -- Beginning in the
- 13 2020-2021 school year and for each school year thereafter, in
- 14 order to graduate from high school or obtain a general
- 15 equivalency diploma, a pupil must correctly answer at least
- 16 sixty per centum (60%) of the questions listed on a test that is

- 1 <u>identical to the civics portion of the naturalization test used</u>
- 2 by the United States Citizenship and Immigration Services.
- 3 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
