AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An
- act relating to the public school system, including certain
- provisions applicable as well to private and parochial
- schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the
- laws relating thereto," in school directors, providing for
- 6 school director training programs.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
- 10 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a
- 11 section to read:
- 12 Section 328. School Director Training Programs. -- (a)
- 13 Beginning in the 2017-2018 school year and in each school year
- 14 thereafter, each newly elected or appointed school director
- 15 shall complete, during the first year of the school director's
- 16 first term, a training program developed and made available by
- 17 the Department of Education, in consultation with a Statewide
- 18 organization representing school directors and a Statewide
- 19 organization representing school business officials, pertaining

- 1 to the skills and knowledge necessary to serve as a school
- 2 director. The training program shall consist of eight (8) hours
- 3 of instruction, to include, at a minimum, information regarding
- 4 the following:
- 5 (1) Instruction and academic programs.
- 6 <u>(2) Personnel.</u>
- 7 <u>(3) Fiscal management.</u>
- 8 <u>(4) Operations.</u>
- 9 <u>(5) Governance.</u>
- 10 (6) ETHICS, TO INCLUDE THE REQUIREMENTS UNDER 65 PA.C.S. PT. <--
- 11 <u>II (RELATING TO ACCOUNTABILITY).</u>
- 12 (b) Within one (1) year after each reelection or
- 13 reappointment to the board of school directors, each school
- 14 <u>director shall complete an advanced training program developed</u>
- 15 and offered by the Department of Education in consultation with
- 16 <u>a Statewide organization representing school directors and a</u>
- 17 Statewide organization representing school business officials.
- 18 The advanced training program shall consist of four (4) hours of
- 19 instruction, including information on relevant changes to
- 20 Federal and State public school law and regulations, fiscal
- 21 management and other information deemed appropriate by the
- 22 Department of Education, to enable the school director to serve
- 23 effectively.
- 24 (c) The Department of Education shall examine options for
- 25 providing the training programs required under this section
- 26 through methods such as online or other distance learning media
- 27 <u>or through regional-based training.</u>
- 28 (d) The training programs required under this section shall
- 29 <u>be developed and offered by the Department of Education at no</u>
- 30 cost to school districts or school directors. THE DEPARTMENT OF <--

- 1 EDUCATION MAY APPROVE TRAINING PROGRAMS THAT FULFILL THE
- 2 REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION WHICH CAN BE PROVIDED BY SCHOOL
- 3 DISTRICTS, INTERMEDIATE UNITS OR POSTSECONDARY INSTITUTIONS.
- 4 (e) Each school director who is in office on the effective
- 5 date of this section shall complete the training program
- 6 required under subsection (a) by June 30, 2018.
- 7 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
