AN ACT

- Amending the act of February 14, 2008 (P.L.6, No.3), entitled 1 "An act providing for access to public information, for a 2 designated open-records officer in each Commonwealth agency, 3 local agency, judicial agency and legislative agency, for procedure, for appeal of agency determination, for judicial review and for the Office of Open Records; imposing 5 penalties; providing for reporting by State-related 7 institutions; requiring the posting of certain State contract 8 information on the Internet; and making related repeals," in preliminary provisions, further providing for definitions; 10 and, in procedure, further providing for exceptions for 11 public records. 12 13 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 14 hereby enacts as follows: 15 Section 1. The definition of "personal financial

- 2 "Personal financial information." An individual's personal

- 4 <u>financial institution</u> account information; bank, credit or
- 5 financial statements; account, routing or PIN numbers; account
- 6 passwords; forms required to be filed with Federal or State
- 7 taxing authorities; employee benefit election information and
- 8 other information relating to an individual's personal finances.

- 10 Section 2. Section 708(c) of the act is amended and
- 11 subsection (b) is amended by adding a paragraph to read:
- 12 Section 708. Exceptions for public records.
- 13 * * *
- 14 (b) Exceptions. -- Except as provided in subsections (c) and
- 15 (d), the following are exempt from access by a requester under
- 16 this act:
- 17 * * *
- 18 (31) An agency's financial institution account numbers,
- 19 routing numbers, credit card numbers and account passwords.
- 20 (c) Financial records. -- The exceptions set forth in
- 21 subsection (b) shall not apply to financial records, except that
- 22 an agency may redact that portion of a financial record
- 23 protected under subsection (b) (1), (2), (3), (4), (5), (6), (16)
- 24 [or], (17) or (31). An agency shall not disclose the identity of
- 25 an individual performing an undercover or covert law enforcement
- 26 activity.

- 28 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
