6	Section 1. Section 1408(c) of Title 4 of the Pennsylvania
7	Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
8	§ 1408. Transfers from State Gaming Fund.

10	(c) Local law enforcement grants
11	(1) Annually, the sum of \$2,000,000 shall be transferred
12	to the board for the purpose of issuing grants to local law
13	enforcement agencies to investigate violations of and enforce
14	laws relating to unlawful gambling in this Commonwealth. For
15	purposes of this subsection, the term "local law enforcement
16	agency" shall include the Pennsylvania State Police when
17	conducting unlawful gambling enforcement and prevention
18	activities [in a municipality which does not have a municipal

1	police department and in which the Pennsylvania State Police
2	provide the municipality with primary police coverage].
3	(2) On July 1 each fiscal year, any portion of the
4	amount transferred under subsection (a) that is unexpended,
5	<u>unencumbered or uncommitted as of June 30 of the prior fiscal</u>
6	year shall automatically lapse and be transferred to the
7	Compulsive and Problem Gambling Treatment Fund established in
8	section 1509 (relating to compulsive and problem gambling
9	program).

11	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
