- 1 Amending Title 20 (Decedents, Estates and Fiduciaries) of the
- 2 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in dispositions
- independent of letters, family exemption, probate of wills
- and grant of letters, further providing for payments to
- 5 family and funeral directors.
- 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 7 hereby enacts as follows:
- 8 Section 1. Section 3101(a) of Title 20 of the Pennsylvania
- 9 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 10 § 3101. Payments to family and funeral directors.
- 11 (a) Wages, salary or employee benefits. -- Any employer of a
- 12 person dying domiciled in this Commonwealth at any time after
- 13 the death of the employee, whether or not a personal
- 14 representative has been appointed, may pay wages, salary or any
- 15 employee benefits due the deceased in an amount not exceeding
- 16 [\$5,000] \$10,000 to the spouse, any child, the father or mother,
- 17 or any sister or brother (preference being given in the order
- 18 named) of the deceased employee. Any employer making such a

- 1 payment shall be released to the same extent as if payment had
- 2 been made to a duly appointed personal representative of the
- 3 decedent and he shall not be required to see to the application
- 4 thereof. Any person to whom payment is made shall be answerable
- 5 therefor to anyone prejudiced by an improper distribution.

- 7 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
