AN ACT

Amending Title 24 (Education) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 1 Statutes, in membership, contributions and benefits, further 2 providing for termination of annuities. 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Section 8346 of Title 24 of the Pennsylvania 6 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read: § 8346. Termination of annuities. 8 9 10 (b.3) Return to school service in a substitute teacher 11 position. --12 (1) An annuitant may be returned to school service in a 13 substitute position, long term or day-to-day, for a period 14 not to exceed 90 days in any school year, without loss of the 15 individual's annuity. In computing the number of days an 16 annuitant has returned to school service, any amount of time

less than 1/2 of a day shall be counted as 1/2 of a day.

1 (2) The annuitant shall not be entitled to earn any 2 credited service and no contributions may be made by the annuitant, the employer or the Commonwealth on account of 3 4 such employment. (3) For purposes of this subsection, the term 5 6 "substitute" shall mean any individual who has been employed to perform the duties of a regular professional employee 7 during such period of time as the regular professional 8 9 employee is absent on sabbatical leave or for other legal cause authorized and approved by the board of school 10 directors or to perform the duties of a temporary 11 professional employee who is absent. 12 * * * 13 14 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
