AN ACT

Amending the act of November 24, 1998 (P.L.882, No.111), 1 entitled "An act providing for victims' rights; imposing 2 penalties; establishing remedies; establishing the Office of 3 Victim Advocate, the Bureau of Victims' Services, the Victims' Services Advisory Committee, the State Offender Supervision Fund and other funds; and making repeals," in 6 miscellaneous provisions, providing for disclosure and 7 confidentiality of victims' records. 8 9 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 10 11 Section 1. The act of November 24, 1998 (P.L.882, No.111), known as the Crime Victims Act, is amended by adding a section 12 13 to read: Section 5101.1. Disclosure and confidentiality of victims' 14 15 records. 16 All records pertaining to a victim in the possession of or 17 maintained by the Office of Victim Advocate, including 18 information regarding a victim's current contact information and 19 any other information or record relating thereto, are the property of the Office of Victim Advocate. The records shall be 2.0

- 1 kept confidential and shall not be subject to the provisions of
- 2 the act of February 14, 2008 (P.L.6, No.3), known as the Right-
- 3 to-Know Law. Victim information and records relating to a victim
- 4 contained in the database or maintained in relation thereto may
- 5 be released by the Office of Victim Advocate to a State or local
- 6 government agency that has a duty or need to maintain contact
- 7 with the victim but shall not be disclosed to any other person
- 8 without the written consent of the victim.
- 9 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
