## AN ACT

- 1 Establishing the Arnold Palmer Trails Program as a system in
- 2 State parks of golf courses that are consistent with the golf
- 3 course design philosophy of Arnold Palmer; prescribing powers
- and duties of the Department of General Services; and
- 5 providing for program funding.
- 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 7 hereby enacts as follows:
- 8 Section 1. Short title.
- 9 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Arnold Palmer
- 10 Trails Act.
- 11 Section 2. Definitions.
- 12 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 13 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 14 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 15 "Department." The Department of General Services of the
- 16 Commonwealth.
- 17 "Program." The Arnold Palmer Trails Program established in
- 18 this act.
- "Select State park." A State park of the Commonwealth

- 1 selected as a site for a golf course as provided in this act.
- 2 Section 3. Arnold Palmer Trails Program.
- 3 The Arnold Palmer Trails Program is established in the
- 4 department. The purpose of the program is to provide for the
- 5 design, construction and management in State parks of golf
- 6 courses that satisfy criteria consistent with other golf courses
- 7 in this Commonwealth that have utilized the golf course design
- 8 philosophy of Arnold Palmer.
- 9 Section 4. Powers and duties of department.
- 10 The department shall:
- 11 (1) Administer the program.
- 12 (2) In consultation with the Department of Conservation
- and Natural Resources, select at least one State park in the
- north, south, east and west regions of this Commonwealth as
- sites for golf courses to be operated and managed by an
- entity that has entered into a contract with the department.
- 17 (3) Within six months of the effective date of this
- 18 section, issue a request for proposals for the design,
- 19 construction and management of golf courses at select State
- 20 parks.
- 21 (4) Within one year of the effective date of this
- 22 section, enter into a contract with the lowest responsible
- 23 bidder for the design, construction and management of golf
- courses at select State parks.
- 25 (5) Take such action as is necessary to obtain a license
- for the use of the name Arnold Palmer in connection with the
- operation of golf courses at select State parks and the
- program.
- 29 (6) Segregate the expenditures for the program from all
- other expenditures of the department in the department's

- 1 annual budget request submitted to the Secretary of the
- 2 Budget as required by law.
- 3 (7) Annually prepare and submit to the Appropriations
- 4 Committee of the Senate and the Appropriations Committee of
- 5 the House of Representatives a report on the status and
- 6 administration of the program.
- 7 (8) To the extent necessary, solicit and accept money
- 8 from any person or entity for the administration of the
- 9 program.
- 10 (9) Establish reasonable fees for playing golf or
- 11 participating in other recreational activities offered at the
- golf courses of the select State parks.
- 13 Section 5. Program funding.
- 14 The department shall administer the program by using the
- 15 following sources of funding:
- 16 (1) Fifty percent of all revenue obtained from
- 17 nonsurface impact leases entered into by the Commonwealth on
- 18 land in State parks and State forests.
- 19 (2) Money appropriated or otherwise made available to
- the department for the program or any other purpose.
- 21 (3) Money solicited and accepted under section 4(8).
- 22 Section 6. Effective date.
- 23 This act shall take effect in 30 days.
