## AN ACT

Amending Title 40 (Insurance) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in regulation of insurers and related persons 1 2 generally, providing for mental health parity and access to 3 addiction treatment. 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 7 Section 1. This chapter relates to a certification of compliance with

- 1 Federal and State insurance laws regarding mental health and
- 2 <u>substance use disorder benefits</u>.
- 3 § 3702. Definitions.
- 4 The following words and phrases when used in this chapter
- 5 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 6 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 7 <u>"Department." The Insurance Department of the Commonwealth.</u>
- 8 "Insurer." An entity that issues or administers health
- 9 <u>insurance policies or health plans and is subject to the</u>
- 10 jurisdiction of the department. The term includes an entity
- 11 organized or existing under, or subject to, any of the
- 12 <u>following:</u>
- 13 (1) The act of May 17, 1921 (P.L.682, No.284), known as
- 14 The Insurance Company Law of 1921.
- 15 (2) The act of December 29, 1972 (P.L.1701, No.364),
- 16 <u>known as the Health Maintenance Organization Act.</u>
- 17 (3) The act of May 18, 1976 (P.L.123, No.54), known as
- 18 <u>the Individual Accident and Sickness Insurance Minimum</u>
- 19 Standards Act.
- 20 <u>(4) Chapter 61 (relating to hospital plan corporations)</u>
- 21 or 63 (relating to professional health services plan
- 22 <u>corporations</u>).
- 23 "MHPAEA." The Paul Wellstone and Pete Domenici Mental Health
- 24 Parity and Addiction Equity Act of 2008 (Public Law 110-343, 122
- 25 Stat. 3881).
- 26 § 3703. Certification.
- No later than January 1 of each year, an insurer that issues
- 28 <u>or administers a health insurance policy or health plan in this</u>
- 29 Commonwealth, including a policy or plan in which mental health
- 30 or substance use disorder benefits are managed by an entity

- 1 other than the insurer, shall file with the department a written
- 2 certification signed by an officer of the insurer under oath
- 3 <u>attesting that:</u>
- 4 (1) The insurer has completed a comprehensive review of
- 5 <u>all health insurance policies and health plans issued or</u>
- 6 administered by the insurer, including policies and plans in
- 7 <u>which mental health or substance use disorder benefits are</u>
- 8 <u>managed by an entity other than the insurer, for compliance</u>
- 9 <u>with the requirements of MHPAEA and its implementing</u>
- 10 <u>regulations and interim final rules and compliance with</u>
- 11 <u>section 604-B of the act of May 17, 1921 (P.L.682, No.284),</u>
- 12 known as The Insurance Company Law of 1921 and its
- implementing regulations.
- 14 (2) All policies and plans under paragraph (1) comply
- 15 with the laws, regulations and interim final rules referred
- to in paragraph (1).
- 17 § 3704. Regulations.
- 18 The department shall promulgate regulations necessary to
- 19 implement this chapter.
- 20 Section 2. All acts and parts of acts are repealed insofar
- 21 as they are inconsistent with this act.
- 22 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
