AN ACT

1 Designating the interchange of State Route 43, the Mon-Fayette
2 Expressway, with Rubles Mill Road, known as Exit 4, Fayette
3 County, as the Master Sergeant Arthur L. Lilley Memorial
4 Interchange.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Master Sergeant Arthur L. Lilley Memorial
8 Interchange.

9 (a) Findings.--The General Assembly finds and declares as
10 follows:

11 (1) Arthur L. Lilley was born on April 19, 1972, to
12 Arthur and Elizabeth Lilley in Uniontown, Pennsylvania.

13 (2) He was a 1990 graduate of Tri-Valley High School in
14 Uniontown, Pennsylvania.

15 (3) In 1990, Arthur L. Lilley joined the United States
16 Army as an infantryman. He served in Operation Desert Shield
17 and Operation Desert Storm as a member of the 101st Airborne
18 Division.

19 (4) In 1992, he was transferred to the 1st Battalion,

1 508th Infantry Regiment, 173rd Infantry Brigade, at Camp
2 Ederle, Italy.

3 (5) After graduating from the Special Forces
4 Qualification Course in 1996, Master Sergeant Lilley was
5 assigned to the 1st Battalion, 7th Special Forces Group as
6 Special Forces Engineer Sergeant.

7 (6) In 2000, Master Sergeant Lilley was assigned to the
8 96th Civil Affairs Battalion at Fort Bragg, North Carolina,
9 where he served as Engineer Sergeant and later as First
10 Sergeant.

11 (7) Master Sergeant Lilley was assigned to the 2nd
12 Battalion, 7th Special Forces Group as an Operational
13 Detachment Alpha Team Sergeant in 2005.

14 (8) On June 15, 2007, Master Sergeant Lilley gave his
15 life in the line of duty at 35 years of age while serving in
16 support of Operation Enduring Freedom in Paktika Province,
17 Afghanistan.

18 (9) Master Sergeant Lilley received numerous
19 commendations, including the Meritorious Service Medal, Army
20 Commendation Medal, Joint Service Achievement Medal, Army
21 Achievement Medal, Army Good Conduct Medal, National Defense
22 Service Medal, Southwest Asia Service Medal, Global War on
23 Terrorism Expeditionary Medal, Global War on Terrorism
24 Service Medal, Humanitarian Service Medal, NCO Professional
25 Development Ribbon, Army Service Ribbon, Overseas Service
26 Ribbon, Kuwait Liberation Medal (Saudi Arabia), Kuwait
27 Liberation Medal (Kuwait), Expert Infantryman Badge, Combat
28 Infantry Badge, Master Parachutist Badge, Air Assault Badge
29 and Special Forces Tab.

30 (10) An active member of his community, Master Sergeant

1 Lilley served as a youth minister at Saint Andrew's United
2 Methodist Church in Fayetteville, North Carolina.

3 (b) Designation.--The interchange of State Route 43, the
4 Mon-Fayette Expressway, with Rubles Mill Road, known as Exit 4,
5 Fayette County, is hereby designated the Master Sergeant Arthur
6 L. Lilley Memorial Interchange.

7 (c) Signs.--The Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission shall erect
8 and maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the
9 interchange.

10 Section 2. Effective date.

11 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
