- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. Section 121(a) of the act of March 10, 1949
- 10 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949,
- 11 amended February 3, 2016 (P.L.1. No.1), is amended and the
- 12 section is amended by adding subsections to read:
- 13 Section 121. Keystone Exams. -- (a) [Subject to annual
- 14 appropriation, not later than the 2020-2021 school year, the]
- 15 The Department of Education shall develop and implement Keystone
- 16 Exams in [the following subjects:] algebra I, literature[,
- 17 biology, English composition, algebra II, geometry, United

- 1 States history, chemistry, civics and government and world
- 2 history.] and biology. The State Board of Education shall
- 3 promulgate regulations, subject to the act of June 25, 1982
- 4 (P.L.633, No.181), known as the "Regulatory Review Act,"
- 5 necessary to implement this section.
- 6 * * *
- 7 (c) Notwithstanding section 2604-B(b)(2)(v), 22 Pa. Code §
- 8 <u>4.24 (relating to high school graduation requirements) or 4.51</u>
- 9 <u>(relating to State assessment system) or any statute or</u>
- 10 regulation to the contrary, in any school year in which a
- 11 <u>demonstration of proficiency on a Keystone Exam is required for</u>
- 12 <u>high school graduation</u>, a student who participates in vocational <--
- 13 <u>education as provided under Article XVIII either in an area</u>
- 14 vocational-technical school or in a school district shall be
- 15 permitted to demonstrate proficiency on a NOCTI exam in lieu of
- 16 demonstrating proficiency on one Keystone Exam. The Department
- 17 of Education shall set a performance level for proficiency on
- 18 the NOCTI exam, which the State Board of Education shall approve
- 19 within six (6) months of the effective date of this section.
- 20 (d) As used in this section, the term "NOCTI exam" means the
- 21 <u>National Occupational Competency Testing Institute exam.</u> A CTE <--
- 22 CONCENTRATOR SHALL BE DEEMED PROFICIENT PROVIDED THAT THE CTE
- 23 CONCENTRATOR SHALL MEET ALL OF THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS:
- 24 (1) COMPLETES LOCALLY ESTABLISHED GRADE-BASED REQUIREMENTS
- 25 FOR ACADEMIC CONTENT AREAS ASSOCIATED WITH EACH KEYSTONE EXAM ON
- 26 WHICH THE CTE CONCENTRATOR DID NOT ACHIEVE PROFICIENCY. FOR THE
- 27 PURPOSES OF THIS PARAGRAPH, COMPLETION OF GRADE-BASED
- 28 REQUIREMENTS IN ANY SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY AND ENVIRONMENT AND
- 29 ECOLOGY COURSE SHALL SATISFY THE REQUIREMENTS FOR THE ACADEMIC
- 30 CONTENT AREA ASSOCIATED WITH THE KEYSTONE EXAM IN BIOLOGY; AND

- 1 (2) COMPLETES ONE OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 2 (I) ATTAINS AN INDUSTRY-BASED COMPETENCY CERTIFICATION
- 3 RELATED TO THE CTE CONCENTRATOR'S PROGRAM OF STUDY; OR
- 4 (II) DEMONSTRATES A HIGH LIKELIHOOD OF SUCCESS ON AN
- 5 APPROVED INDUSTRY-BASED COMPETENCY ASSESSMENT OR READINESS FOR
- 6 CONTINUED MEANINGFUL ENGAGEMENT IN THE CTE CONCENTRATOR'S
- 7 PROGRAM OF STUDY AS DEMONSTRATED BY PERFORMANCE ON BENCHMARK
- 8 ASSESSMENTS, COURSE GRADES AND OTHER FACTORS CONSISTENT WITH THE
- 9 <u>CTE CONCENTRATOR'S GOALS AND CAREER PLAN.</u>
- 10 (D) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, THE FOLLOWING WORDS AND PHRASES
- 11 SHALL HAVE THE MEANINGS GIVEN TO THEM IN THIS SUBSECTION UNLESS
- 12 THE CONTEXT CLEARLY INDICATES OTHERWISE:
- 13 "APPROVED INDUSTRY-BASED COMPETENCY ASSESSMENT." A NOCTI
- 14 EXAM, NIMS ASSESSMENT OR OTHER INDUSTRY-BASED COMPETENCY
- 15 ASSESSMENT IDENTIFIED BY THE SECRETARY OF EDUCATION AND APPROVED
- 16 BY THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION.
- 17 "CTE CONCENTRATOR." A STUDENT WHO, BY THE END OF A REPORTING
- 18 YEAR, WILL BE REPORTED AS SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETING AT LEAST 50
- 19 PERCENT OF THE MINIMUM TECHNICAL INSTRUCTIONAL HOURS REQUIRED
- 20 UNDER 22 PA. CODE CH. 339 (RELATING TO VOCATIONAL EDUCATION).
- 21 "NIMS ASSESSMENT." AN ASSESSMENT BASED ON THE NATIONAL
- 22 INSTITUTE FOR METALWORKING SKILLS STANDARDS.
- 23 "NOCTI EXAM." A NATIONAL OCCUPATIONAL COMPETENCY TESTING
- 24 INSTITUTE EXAM.
- 25 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
