## AN ACT

- Repealing the act of May 8, 2012 (P.L.254, No.38), entitled "An act relating to compliance with the Federal REAL ID Act of
- 3 2005."
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. The act of May 8, 2012 (P.L.254, No.38), known as
- 7 the REAL ID Nonparticipation Act, is repealed:
- 8 [An Act
- 9 Relating to compliance with the Federal REAL ID Act of 2005.
- 10 Section 1. Short title.
- 11 This act shall be known and may be cited as the REAL ID
- 12 Nonparticipation Act.
- 13 Section 2. Participation in the REAL ID Act of 2005.
- 14 (a) Prohibition. -- Neither the Governor nor the Department of
- 15 Transportation or any other Commonwealth agency shall
- 16 participate in the REAL ID Act of 2005 or regulations
- 17 promulgated thereunder.
- 18 (b) Definition.--As used in this section, the term "REAL ID

- 1 Act of 2005" means Division B of the Emergency Supplemental
- 2 Appropriations Act for Defense, the Global War on Terror and
- 3 Tsunami Relief, 2005 (Public Law 109-13, 119 Stat. 302).
- 4 Section 3. Legal challenge.
- 5 Either the Governor or the Attorney General may file an
- 6 action in a court of competent jurisdiction to challenge the
- 7 constitutionality or legality of the REAL ID Act of 2005.
- 8 Section 20. Effective date.
- 9 This act shall take effect in 60 days.]
- 10 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
