INTRODUCED AS NONCONTROVERSIAL RESOLUTION UNDER RULE 35, JANUARY 21, 2015

A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commemorating February 19, 2015, as "The Battle of Iwo Jima Remembrance Day" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, February 19, 2015, marks the 70th anniversary of the
- 4 start of the Battle of Iwo Jima, where the United States Armed
- 5 Forces captured the island of Iwo Jima from the Japanese Empire;
- 6 and
- WHEREAS, On February 19, 1945, the amphibious landing began
- 8 by the United States Marines with 450 American ships, 60,000
- 9 Marines and 10,000 Navy Seabees and occurred off the coast of
- 10 Iwo Jima; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Shortly after 9 a.m., under protective Naval
- 12 gunfire, the United States Marines arrived on the beach of Iwo
- 13 Jima and encountered little enemy resistance until the Japanese

- 1 emerged from their underground positions; and
- 2 WHEREAS, The 36-day assault from February 19 to March 26,
- 3 1945, claimed the lives of 6,821 American troops and wounded
- 4 19,217, and two solders were taken into captivity; and
- 5 WHEREAS, The Japanese on the island lost 18,844 of their
- 6 22,060 soldiers in the fighting or by ritual suicide, an
- 7 additional 216 were captured and approximately 300 were hidden
- 8 in caves and tunnels for days; and
- 9 WHEREAS, The Battle of Iwo Jima saw one-third of all Marines
- 10 killed in World War II, resulting in the battle with the most
- 11 casualties in Marine Corps history; and
- 12 WHEREAS, After the Battle of Iwo Jima, the island served as
- 13 an emergency landing site for more than 2,200 B-29 bombers;
- 14 therefore be it
- 15 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives commemorate
- 16 February 19, 2015, as "The Battle of Iwo Jima Remembrance Day";
- 17 and be it further
- 18 RESOLVED, That local governments and communities throughout
- 19 this Commonwealth be encouraged to conduct appropriate "The
- 20 Battle of Iwo Jima Remembrance Day" observances to ensure that
- 21 the many sacrifices of that day are not forgotten.
