## A RESOLUTION

- Designating February 7 through 14, 2015, as "Congenital Heart Defect Awareness Week" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Congenital heart defects are the most frequently
- 4 occurring birth defect and the leading cause of birth defect-
- 5 related deaths worldwide; and
- 6 WHEREAS, More than one million families across this nation
- 7 are facing the challenges and hardships of raising children with
- 8 congenital heart defects; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Every year 40,000 babies are born in the United
- 10 States with congenital heart defects; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Some congenital heart defects are not diagnosed
- 12 until months or years after birth; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Undiagnosed congenital heart conditions cause many
- 14 cases of sudden cardiac death in young athletes; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Despite these statistics, newborns and young

- 1 athletes are not routinely screened for congenital heart
- 2 defects; and
- 3 WHEREAS, A disproportionately small amount of funding is
- 4 available for congenital heart defect research and support; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Congenital Heart Defect Awareness Week provides an
- 6 opportunity for families whose lives have been affected to
- 7 celebrate life and to remember loved ones lost, to honor
- 8 dedicated health professionals and to meet others and know they
- 9 are not alone; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Establishment of Congenital Heart Defect Awareness
- 11 Week will also provide the opportunity to share experience and
- 12 information with the public and the media in order to raise
- 13 public awareness about congenital heart defects; therefore be it
- 14 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate
- 15 February 7 through 14, 2015, as "Congenital Heart Defect
- 16 Awareness Week" in Pennsylvania; and be it further
- 17 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives encourage all
- 18 residents to increase awareness, education and services for
- 19 congenital heart defects each year which affect thousands of
- 20 babies in Pennsylvania.
