A RESOLUTION

- 1 Honoring Ron Cohen, legendary head coach of the George
 - Washington High School football team located in Northeast
- Philadelphia, who is retiring after a distinguished career of
- 4 coaching and teaching.
- 5 WHEREAS, On February 17, 2015, Coach Ron Cohen is retiring as
- 6 head coach of the George Washington High School football team
- 7 after a remarkable coaching career spanning 30 years during
- 8 which his teams were dominant in the City of Philadelphia's
- 9 Public League; and

- 10 WHEREAS, Over the course of 30 seasons as head coach, Coach
- 11 Cohen compiled an impressive overall record of 261 wins, 84
- 12 losses and 2 ties, which is a .757 winning percentage, and his
- 13 teams won 12 Public League championships; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Coach Cohen graduated from Germantown High School in
- 15 Philadelphia in 1961, having lettered in football, baseball and
- 16 track; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Coach Cohen played football for the Temple

- 1 University Owls; and
- 2 WHEREAS, In 1966, Coach Cohen earned a degree in health and
- 3 physical education from Temple University; and
- 4 WHEREAS, In 1985, Coach Cohen became head coach of the George
- 5 Washington High School football team after having served as an
- 6 assistant coach at Simon Gratz High School, Roxborough High
- 7 School and Lincoln High School; and
- 8 WHEREAS, In Coach Cohen's first season as head coach for the
- 9 George Washington High School Eagles, his football team earned a
- 10 berth in the Public League Championship Game; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Under Coach Cohen's capable guidance, the Eagles won
- 12 league titles in 12 seasons, including the years 1989, 1991,
- 13 1992, 1994, 1995, 2000, 2001, 2004, 2007, 2008, 2009 and 2011;
- 14 and
- 15 WHEREAS, Coach Cohen was a three-time winner of the
- 16 Philadelphia Eagles Coach of the Month Award; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Coach Cohen is the first coach in the history of
- 18 George Washington High School's football program to win 10
- 19 consecutive games; and
- 20 WHEREAS, Coach Cohen has been named "Coach of the Year" on
- 21 nine different occasions; and
- 22 WHEREAS, Coach Cohen holds the City of Philadelphia record
- 23 for most high school football playoff wins, with 55; and
- 24 WHEREAS, Coach Cohen has coached seven football players who
- 25 were named to play in the annual Big 33 Football Classic all-
- 26 star game, including four players who have gone on to play in
- 27 the National Football League; and
- 28 WHEREAS, Coach Cohen was named as the "Coach of the Decade"
- 29 by the Philadelphia Daily News; and
- 30 WHEREAS, In 2001, Coach Cohen was elected to the City All-

- 1 Star Chapter of the Pennsylvania Sports Hall of Fame; and
- 2 WHEREAS, Coach Cohen created the concept of building four
- 3 athletic Supersites, artificial turf fields and all-weather
- 4 tracks that can be utilized by all student athletes in the City
- 5 of Philadelphia; and
- 6 WHEREAS, From 2004 through 2005, Coach Cohen served on the
- 7 District 12 steering committee that paved the way for the Public
- 8 League's entrance into the Pennsylvania Interscholastic Athletic
- 9 Association and the development of the four Supersites; and
- 10 WHEREAS, In 2007, in Hershey, Pennsylvania, Coach Cohen was
- 11 elected to the Pennsylvania Scholastic Football Coaches Football
- 12 Hall of Fame; and
- 13 WHEREAS, In 2013, Coach Cohen was inducted into the
- 14 Philadelphia Jewish Sports Hall of Fame for his accomplishments
- 15 during his coaching and teaching career; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Although Coach Cohen's on-field success is
- 17 considerable, he counts as his greatest achievement and
- 18 privilege the positive influence he has had on his students in
- 19 his capacity as a coach and teacher for more than 48 years; and
- 20 WHEREAS, Despite the challenges inherent in growing up in an
- 21 inner-city environment, some of Coach Cohen's students have
- 22 earned college degrees and, with numerous others, have become
- 23 responsible adults leading positive lives; therefore be it
- 24 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives honor
- 25 distinguished coach and teacher Ron Cohen for his outstanding
- 26 leadership as head coach of the George Washington High School
- 27 football team located in Northeast Philadelphia and note his
- 28 dedication to serving as a mentor, counselor and friend and
- 29 positively influencing countless young lives during his
- 30 distinguished career.
