A RESOLUTION

- 1 Urging the Congress of the United States to defeat H.R. 707 and 2 any other legislation which would prohibit states from
- authorizing and conducting Internet gaming.
- auchorizing and conducting interince gaming.
- 4 WHEREAS, The Restoration of America's Wire Act, introduced as
- 5 H.R. 707 in the 114th Congress, would prohibit the transmission
- 6 by wire communication of any bet or wager or of information
- 7 assisting in the placement of any bet or wager, including
- 8 Internet gaming; and
- 9 WHEREAS, A Federal prohibition against Internet gaming would
- 10 directly and negatively impact Pennsylvania by foreclosing the
- 11 future potential of Internet gaming to generate tax revenue, to
- 12 create economic and employment opportunities, including high-
- 13 tech software jobs, and to foster valuable business ventures for
- 14 Pennsylvania casinos; and
- 15 WHEREAS, If enacted, H.R. 707 would prohibit the Commonwealth
- 16 from authorizing and conducting Internet gaming and from
- 17 capturing new tax revenue for Pennsylvania; and
- 18 WHEREAS, This prohibition would preclude the Commonwealth's

- 1 ability to create a legitimate online gaming industry within its
- 2 borders, drive illegal operators out of business and protect
- 3 consumers; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Passage of this measure as Federal law would be
- 5 inimical to the interests of this Commonwealth, which has been
- 6 at the forefront of a well-regulated casino gaming industry for
- 7 nearly a decade and which recognizes the benefits of Internet
- 8 gaming and its future potential; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Over the course of our nation's history, state
- 10 governments, not the Federal Government, have determined what
- 11 forms of gambling should be legal or illegal within their
- 12 borders and, if legal, how gambling should be regulated or
- 13 controlled; therefore be it
- 14 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the
- 15 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania urge the Congress of the United
- 16 States to defeat the Restoration of America's Wire Act,
- 17 introduced as H.R. 707 in the 114th Congress, which prohibits
- 18 the transmission by wire communication of any bet or wager or of
- 19 information assisting in the placement of any bet or wager,
- 20 including Internet gaming; and be it further
- 21 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the
- 22 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania implore the Pennsylvania
- 23 Congressional Delegation to unequivocally oppose H.R. 707, which
- 24 would unduly ban Internet gaming and violate the rights and
- 25 protections guaranteed to the states under the 10th Amendment of
- 26 the Constitution of the United States; and be it further
- 27 RESOLVED, That copies of this resolution be transmitted to
- 28 each member of Congress from Pennsylvania.
