- 1 Honoring Rocco Mediate for his outstanding career as a
- professional golfer.
- 3 WHEREAS, Rocco Mediate was born December 17, 1962, in
- 4 Greensburg; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Mr. Mediate attended Florida Southern College and
- 6 was a member of the golf team, leading the college to the 1985
- 7 Division II national team championship; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Mr. Mediate turned professional in 1985; and
- 9 WHEREAS, In 1991, Mr. Mediate became the first player to win
- 10 on the PGA Tour by using a long putter when he won the Doral-
- 11 Ryder Open; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Mr. Mediate has been featured in the top 20 of the
- 13 Official World Golf Ranking and is considered to be one of the
- 14 best putters in golf; and
- 15 WHEREAS, The most notable moment of Mr. Mediate's career was
- 16 during the 2008 U.S. Open at the Torrey Pines South course where

- 1 he finished runner-up after losing in an 18-hole playoff to
- 2 Tiger Woods; and
- 3 WHEREAS, In 2010, Mr. Mediate became the oldest wire-to-wire
- 4 winner on the PGA Tour since at least 1970; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Mr. Mediate has a total of twelve professional wins,
- 6 including six PGA Tour wins, two Champions Tour wins and four
- 7 additional wins; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Mr. Mediate is currently on the PGA Tour and
- 9 Champions Tour; therefore be it
- 10 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives honor Rocco
- 11 Mediate for his outstanding career as a professional golfer.
