A RESOLUTION

- Designating the month of May 2015 as "Cystic Fibrosis Awareness Month" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Cystic fibrosis (CF) is a genetic disease affecting
- 4 approximately 30,000 children and adults in the United States
- 5 and nearly 70,000 children and adults worldwide, 1,659 of whom
- 6 live in this Commonwealth; and
- 7 WHEREAS, A defective gene causes the body to produce an
- 8 abnormally thick, sticky mucus that clogs the lungs, and these
- 9 secretions produce life-threatening lung infections and obstruct
- 10 the pancreas, preventing digestive enzymes from reaching the
- 11 intestines to help break down and absorb food; and
- 12 WHEREAS, More than 10 million Americans are symptomless
- 13 carriers of the defective CF gene, and CF occurs in
- 14 approximately one of every 3,500 live births in the United

- 1 States; and
- 2 WHEREAS, The median age of survival for a person with CF is
- 3 41.1 years; and
- 4 WHEREAS, With advances in the treatment of CF, the number of
- 5 adults with CF has steadily grown, and approximately 1,000 new
- 6 cases of CF are diagnosed each year; and
- WHEREAS, Nearly 50% of the CF population is 18 years of age
- 8 and older, and people with CF have a variety of symptoms
- 9 attributed to the more than 1,800 mutations of the CF gene; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Infant blood screening to detect genetic defects is
- 11 the most reliable and least costly method to identify persons
- 12 likely to have CF; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Early diagnosis of CF permits early treatment and
- 14 enhances quality of life and longevity and the treatment of CF
- 15 depends on the stage of the disease and the organs involved; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Clearing mucus from the lungs is an important part
- 17 of the daily CF treatment regimen, and other types of treatments
- 18 include inhaled antibiotics and pancreatic enzymes, among
- 19 others; and
- 20 WHEREAS, There are 11 world-class treatment centers in this
- 21 Commonwealth which specialize in the diagnosis of CF and the
- 22 care of persons with CF; and
- 23 WHEREAS, Improving the length and quality of life for people
- 24 with CF starts with awareness; therefore be it
- 25 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the
- 26 month of May 2015 as "Cystic Fibrosis Awareness Month" in
- 27 Pennsylvania.
