A RESOLUTION

- Designating the month of August 2015 as "Kidney Cancer Awareness Month" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Each year more than 50,000 people in the United
- 4 States are diagnosed with kidney cancer; and
- 5 WHEREAS, More than 200,000 kidney cancer survivors are
- 6 currently living in the United States; and
- 7 WHEREAS, The exact cause of kidney cancer is unknown; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Kidney cancer occurs nearly twice as often in men as
- 9 in women and occurs mostly in men over 40 years of age; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Early detection can help offset the spread of kidney
- 11 cancer; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Other than surgery, the most commonly used
- 13 treatments for kidney cancer are immunotherapy, radiation and
- 14 chemotherapy; and

- 1 WHEREAS, Recent advances in diagnosis, surgical procedures
- 2 and treatment options have given renewed hope to patients who
- 3 previously had fewer options; therefore be it
- 4 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the
- 5 month of August 2015 as "Kidney Cancer Awareness Month" in
- 6 Pennsylvania; and be it further
- 7 RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be transmitted to
- 8 the Kidney Cancer Association.
