A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring community health centers for providing quality and
2 affordable primary and preventive health care services for 50
3 years.

4 WHEREAS, Community health centers, also known as federally
5 qualified health centers, were nationally founded in 1965 and
6 this Commonwealth welcomed its first health center to Pittsburgh
7 in 1968; and

8 WHEREAS, It is the mission of all community health centers to
9 provide primary medical, dental and behavioral health services
10 to all individuals regardless of their income or access to
11 insurance; and

12 WHEREAS, Community health centers are the largest network of
13 primary care providers serving vulnerable residents of this
14 Commonwealth in need of primary care; and

15 WHEREAS, Community health centers can only be established in

1 communities that lack access to primary care or have significant
2 poverty rates; and

3 WHEREAS, Community health centers provide primary care
4 services through their dedicated health-professional employees
5 and the team-based approach they take to effective patient-
6 centered primary care; and

7 WHEREAS, Community health centers are nonprofit organizations
8 directed by their community majority-based board of directors to
9 be reflective of the community and patients they serve; and

10 WHEREAS, Community health centers provide primary care to
11 more than 700,000 patients Statewide; and

12 WHEREAS, Community health centers have expanded their
13 services to more than 250 sites serving patients in 49 rural and
14 urban counties of this Commonwealth; and

15 WHEREAS, Community health centers have demonstrated the
16 ability to serve more individuals challenged by social
17 determinants of health, such as poverty, and with complex
18 medical conditions in a highly effective and cost-efficient
19 manner; and

20 WHEREAS, Community health centers are highly transparent by
21 providing clinical outcome measures to the public over multiple
22 years; and

23 WHEREAS, Community health centers have led health care
24 industry standards by having a majority of them attain Patient-
25 Centered Medical Home recognition and implementing electronic
26 health records to better serve their patients; therefore be it

27 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives honor community
28 health centers for providing quality primary care to residents
29 of this Commonwealth for 50 years; and be it further
