## A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

2 3 4	Commission to study the academic and financial needs of Cheyney University of Pennsylvania and make recommendations to ensure its viability in the future.
5	WHEREAS, Cheyney University of Pennsylvania was founded in
6	1837 as the Institute for Colored Youth in Philadelphia; and
7	WHEREAS, Richard Humphreys, a Quaker philanthropist, set
8	aside \$10,000, approximately one-tenth of his estate, to design
9	and establish the Institute for Colored Youth, in order to
10	educate descendants of the African race; and
11	WHEREAS, The Institute for Colored Youth successfully
12	provided free classical education for qualified individuals; and
13	WHEREAS, In 1902, the school moved to George Cheyney's farm
14	located 25 miles outside Philadelphia; and
15	WHEREAS, The school was renamed several times over the years,
16	as Cheyney Training School for Teachers in 1914, Cheyney State
17	Teachers College in 1951 and the Cheyney State College in 1959,
18	before joining the State System of Higher Education in 1983 as
19	Cheyney University of Pennsylvania; and

- 1 WHEREAS, Cheyney University is known as America's first
- 2 institution of higher learning for African-American students;
- 3 and
- WHEREAS, Cheyney University has more than 30,000 graduates,
- 5 including alumni such as Ed Bradley of "60 Minutes," Robert W.
- 6 Bogle, the publisher and CEO of the Philadelphia Tribune, which
- 7 is the oldest newspaper continuously owned and operated by an
- 8 African American, Michael Coard, a nationally respected attorney
- 9 and journalist, and Pedro Rivera, Secretary of Education of the
- 10 Commonwealth; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Cheyney University's mission is to prepare
- 12 confident, competent, reflective and visionary leaders and
- 13 responsible citizens; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Cheyney University has a tradition of academic
- 15 excellence while maintaining its historical commitment to
- 16 opportunity and access for students of diverse backgrounds; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Cheyney University is facing academic and financial
- 18 challenges that may render its future uncertain as an
- 19 institution of higher education; and
- 20 WHEREAS, Many of the academic and financial challenges faced
- 21 by the university stem from inadequate funding, capital needs
- 22 and poor recruitment; therefore be it
- 23 RESOLVED (the Senate concurring), That the 21st Century
- 24 Cheyney University State Commission be established to study the
- 25 academic and financial needs of Cheyney University of
- 26 Pennsylvania and make recommendations to ensure its viability in
- 27 the future; and be it further
- 28 RESOLVED, That the 21st Century Cheyney University State
- 29 Commission consist of 21 members who shall be appointed as
- 30 follows within 25 days after the adoption of this resolution by

- 1 both chambers:
- 2 (1) The chairperson and minority chairperson of the
- 3 Education Committee of the Senate and the chairperson and
- 4 minority chairperson of the Education Committee of the House
- 5 of Representatives or their designees.
- 6 (2) The Director of the Independent Fiscal Office or a
- 7 designee.
- 8 (3) The Executive Director of the Legislative Budget and
- 9 Finance Committee or a designee.
- 10 (4) The Chancellor of the State System of Higher
- 11 Education or a designee.
- 12 (5) The chairperson of the Board of Governors of the
- 13 State System of Higher Education or a designee.
- 14 (6) The Secretary of Education or a designee.
- 15 (7) The Secretary of the Budget or a designee.
- 16 (8) The President of Cheyney University of Pennsylvania
- 17 or a designee.
- 18 (9) The chairperson of the Council of Trustees of
- 19 Cheyney University of Pennsylvania or a designee.
- 20 (10) Nine individuals appointed by the Governor who
- 21 represent the education, finance, business and workforce
- 22 communities;
- 23 and be it further
- 24 RESOLVED, That the 21st Century Cheyney University State
- 25 Commission appoint a member to serve as the chairperson of the
- 26 commission; and be it further
- 27 RESOLVED, That the 21st Century Cheyney University State
- 28 Commission hold its first meeting within 45 days after the
- 29 adoption of this resolution by both chambers, regardless of the
- 30 status of the appointments under this resolution; and be it

- 2 RESOLVED, That the 21st Century Cheyney University State
- 3 Commission hold meetings at the call of the chairperson; and be
- 4 it further
- 5 RESOLVED, That the members of the 21st Century Cheyney
- 6 University State Commission not receive compensation for their
- 7 services but be reimbursed for all necessary travel and other
- 8 reasonable expenses incurred in connection with the
- 9 performance of their duties as members of the commission; and be
- 10 it further
- 11 RESOLVED, That the General Assembly provide administrative
- 12 support, meeting space and any other assistance required by the
- 13 21st Century Cheyney University State Commission to carry out
- 14 its duties under this resolution; and be it further
- 15 RESOLVED, That the 21st Century Cheyney University State
- 16 Commission devise short-term and long-term plans to address the
- 17 academic and financial needs of Cheyney University of
- 18 Pennsylvania; and be it further
- 19 RESOLVED, That the 21st Century Cheyney University State
- 20 Commission issue a report containing its findings and
- 21 recommendations to the General Assembly no later than six months
- 22 after the adoption of this resolution by both chambers.
