A RESOLUTION

1 2	Designating the month of September 2015 as "Ovarian Cancer Awareness Month" in Pennsylvania.
3	WHEREAS, Every woman is at risk for ovarian cancer regardless
4	of age, heritage or medical history; and
5	WHEREAS, According to the American Cancer Society, a woman's
6	risk of being diagnosed with ovarian cancer during her lifetime
7	is 1 in 75; and
8	WHEREAS, Ovarian cancer is the ninth most common cancer among
9	women and the fifth leading cause of cancer death among women;

L1	WHEREAS, Approximately one-half of the women with ovarian
L2	cancer are 63 years of age or older; and

1 WHEREAS, The American Cancer Society estimates that there will be approximately 21,290 new cases of ovarian cancer in the 2 United States in 2015 and that 14,180 women will die from 3 ovarian cancer in 2015; and 4 5 WHEREAS, Approximately one-fifth of ovarian cancers are found at an early stage; and 6 WHEREAS, Early detection improves the chances of survival; 7 and 8 9 WHEREAS, Nine out of ten women treated for early ovarian cancer will live longer than five years after the cancer is 10 11 found; and WHEREAS, Ovarian cancer awareness and education are important 12 13 factors in diagnosis and treatment; therefore be it 14 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the month of September 2015 as "Ovarian Cancer Awareness Month" in 15 16 Pennsylvania.
