A RESOLUTION

- 1 Designating April 15, 2016, as "Purple Up! Day" in Pennsylvania.
- WHEREAS, Since September 11, 2001, more than 30,000
- 3 Pennsylvania National Guard members, reservists and active-duty
- 4 personnel have been deployed in support of the Global War on
- 5 Terrorism; and
- 6 WHEREAS, More than 32,000 children in this Commonwealth have
- 7 at least one parent currently serving in the National Guard,
- 8 Reserves or active components of the armed forces; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Nationwide, more than 700,000 children have
- 10 experienced the deployment of one or more parents since 2001;
- 11 and
- 12 WHEREAS, More than 40% of military personnel have children
- 13 who are left behind during these deployments; and
- 14 WHEREAS, The month of April has been observed as the "Month

- 1 of the Military Child"; and
- 2 WHEREAS, The United States Department of Defense, armed
- 3 services, cabinet agencies and the White House initiative
- 4 Joining Forces, as well as nonprofit organizations, businesses
- 5 and communities throughout our nation, join in this observance;
- 6 and
- 7 WHEREAS, It is fitting that we recognize and honor the
- 8 sacrifices and celebrate the spirit of our men and women in
- 9 uniform; and
- 10 WHEREAS, It is fitting that we let our men and women in
- 11 uniform know that we are taking care of their children while
- 12 they are protecting us; and
- 13 WHEREAS, When parents serve in the military, their children
- 14 serve as well; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Purple, symbolizing all branches of the military, is
- 16 worn as a tribute to our bravely serving men and women;
- 17 therefore be it
- 18 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate April
- 19 15, 2016, as "Purple Up! Day" in Pennsylvania; and be it further
- 20 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives encourage all
- 21 Pennsylvanians to show support for our military children by
- 22 wearing the color purple on April 15, 2016; and be it further
- 23 RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be transmitted to
- 24 every military installation in this Commonwealth.
