A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing April 28, 2016, as "Take Our Daughters And Sons To
2 Work Day" in Pennsylvania to coincide with the 23rd annual
3 national and international observance.

4 WHEREAS, The House of Representatives affirms the
5 significance of maximizing communication, inclusion and outreach
6 in our workplaces and communities; and

7 WHEREAS, "Take Our Daughters And Sons To Work Day" is a
8 unique educational experience for the benefit of boys and girls
9 between 8 and 18 years of age; and

10 WHEREAS, More than 40 million children, young adults, parents
11 and mentors are participating in 2016 "Take Our Daughters And
12 Sons To Work Day" events at more than 3 million workplaces in
13 the United States and abroad on the fourth Thursday in April;
14 and

15 WHEREAS, The Take Our Daughters And Sons To Work Foundation,

1 a nonprofit organization promoting public awareness of
2 children's issues through work-based learning activities,
3 administers this observance; and

4 WHEREAS, Participants explore work-life integration, learn
5 new skills and goal-setting principles and engage in new and
6 continuing partnerships with other children and adults; and

7 WHEREAS, Moving forward, the Take Our Daughters And Sons To
8 Work Foundation is expanding its program through science,
9 technology, engineering and math educational opportunities and
10 an increased Internet presence; and

11 WHEREAS, "Sparking Aha! Moments," the theme for the 2016
12 observance, celebrates the sudden flashes of insight that fuel
13 our personal and collective discoveries; therefore be it

14 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize April
15 28, 2016, as "Take Our Daughters And Sons To Work Day" in
16 Pennsylvania to coincide with the 23rd annual national and
17 international observance.
