| 12 | Jehovah's Witnesses, Soviet prisoners of war and political |

2 WHEREAS, The people of this Commonwealth should always 3 remember the atrocities committed by the Nazis so that such 4 horrors are never repeated; and

5 WHEREAS, The people of this Commonwealth should continually 6 rededicate themselves to the principle of equal justice for all; 7 and

8 WHEREAS, The people of this Commonwealth should remain 9 vigilant against all tyranny and recognize that bigotry provides 10 a breeding ground for tyranny to flourish; and 11 WHEREAS, May 5, 2016, recognized in the Hebrew calendar as 27 12 Nisan 5776, has been designated internationally as a "Day of 13 Remembrance of Victims of the Nazi Holocaust" and is also known 14 as Yom Hashoah; and

15 WHEREAS, This date further coincides with the anniversary of 16 the Warsaw ghetto uprising in German-occupied Poland from April 17 19 through May 16, 1943; and

18 WHEREAS, It is appropriate for the people of this 19 Commonwealth to join in the international commemoration of this 20 solemn event; and

21 WHEREAS, By marking this occasion in memory of the millions 22 of victims of the Holocaust, we hope to overcome prejudice and 23 inhumanity through education, vigilance and resistance; 24 therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate May 2 through 8, 2016, as "Days of Remembrance of the Victims of the Holocaust" and May 5, 2016, as "Holocaust Remembrance Day" in Pennsylvania.
