A RESOLUTION

1 Commemorating the 100th anniversary of the Pennsylvania Chamber
2 of Business and Industry.

3 WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania Chamber of Business and Industry
4 will be celebrating its centennial anniversary throughout 2016,
5 and December 16, 2016, will mark its actual 100th anniversary;

7 WHEREAS, In 100 years, the Pennsylvania Chamber of Business
8 and Industry has grown from a membership of 100 influential
9 business leaders at its inception to more than 8,000 members
10 today, which comprises nearly 50% of the private work force in
11 this Commonwealth; and

12 WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania Chamber of Business and Industry is

1 one of only five state chambers to be "accredited with
2 distinction" by the United States Chamber of Commerce; and

3 WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania Chamber of Business and Industry
4 strives to stand by its mission as the "Statewide Voice of
5 Business" while continuing to build a better Pennsylvania
6 through pro-growth, pro-jobs and pro-business policies; and

7 WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania Chamber of Business and Industry
8 will hold several events throughout this Commonwealth as part of
9 a year-long celebration that will include: In the Footsteps of
10 Leaders, a leadership training program to be held in Gettysburg
11 on May 11 and 12, 2016; a workforce summit featuring Mike Rowe
12 on May 18, 2016; and the 32nd Annual Chamber Dinner on September
13 26, 2016; and

14 WHEREAS, A new logo and branding identity, "A New Century. A
15 New Look," was unveiled to coincide with the landmark
16 anniversary and better capture the growth of business and
17 industry the Chamber has fostered; and
