A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing the week of May 15 through 21, 2016, as "Emergency  
2 Medical Services Week" in Pennsylvania.

3 WHEREAS, Emergency medical services are a vital public  
4 service; and

5 WHEREAS, The members of emergency medical services teams are  
6 ready to provide lifesaving care to those in need 24 hours a  
7 day, seven days a week; and

8 WHEREAS, Access to quality emergency care dramatically  
9 improves the survival and recovery rate of those who experience  
10 sudden illness or injury; and

11 WHEREAS, The emergency medical services system consists of  
12 emergency physicians, emergency nurses, rescue personnel,  
13 emergency medical technicians, advanced emergency medical  
14 technicians, paramedics, prehospital nurses, prehospital

1 physician extenders, air medical personnel, emergency medical  
2 responders, emergency vehicle operators, firefighters, police  
3 officers, educators, dispatchers, administrators and others; and

4 WHEREAS, The members of emergency medical services teams,  
5 whether career or volunteer, engage in thousands of hours of  
6 specialized training and continuing education to enhance their  
7 lifesaving skills; and

8 WHEREAS, It is appropriate to recognize the value and the  
9 accomplishments of emergency medical services providers;

11 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the  
12 week of May 15 through 21, 2016, as "Emergency Medical Services  
13 Week" in Pennsylvania.
