INTRODUCED AS NONCONTROVERSIAL RESOLUTION UNDER RULE 35, JUNE 1, 2016

A RESOLUTION

1 Designating the month of June 2016 as "Dairy Month" and "Dairy
2 Farmers Appreciation Month" in Pennsylvania.

3 WHEREAS, Dairy farming serves as a primary economic driver
4 behind the number one industry in Pennsylvania, which is
5 agriculture; and

6 WHEREAS, Dairy farming is a proud family tradition in this
7 Commonwealth, where 99% of dairy farms are family owned; and

8 WHEREAS, There are 7,426 dairy herds registered with the
9 Department of Agriculture of the Commonwealth, and approximately
10 530,000 cows, with each cow producing approximately 2,352
11 gallons of milk per year; and

12 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania has the second-largest number of dairy
13 farms nationally and ranks fifth nationally in total milk

1 production; and

2 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania's dairy farms serve as the ideal model
3 for sustainable rural economic development; and

4 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania's many picturesque dairy farms have
5 been a mainstay in the renowned beauty of the rural Pennsylvania
6 landscape for centuries; therefore be it

7 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the
8 month of June 2016 as "Dairy Month" and "Dairy Farmers
9 Appreciation Month" in Pennsylvania and recognize the
10 outstanding contributions of Pennsylvania's dairy farmers to the
11 health and the historical, cultural, environmental and economic
12 success of this Commonwealth.
