A RESOLUTION

- Designating the month of September 2016 as "Light the Night Walk Month" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, The Leukemia & Lymphoma Society (LLS) has a mission
- 4 focused on curing leukemia, lymphoma, Hodgkin's disease and
- 5 myeloma and improving the quality of life for blood cancer
- 6 patients and their families; and
- 7 WHEREAS, LLS operates as the world's largest voluntary health
- 8 agency dedicated to blood cancer; and
- 9 WHEREAS, LLS funds lifesaving blood cancer research around
- 10 the world and provides free information and support services;
- 11 and
- 12 WHEREAS, LLS invested \$67.2 million in funding for
- 13 breakthrough blood cancer research in 2015; and
- 14 WHEREAS, LLS's key priorities help to ensure that blood

- 1 cancer patients live better, longer lives; and
- 2 WHEREAS, The Leukemia & Lymphoma Society's Light the Night
- 3 Walk funds lifesaving research and access to treatment, support
- 4 programs and educational materials for people battling blood
- 5 cancer; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Friends, families and coworkers form fundraising
- 7 teams, and millions of consumers aid LLS's efforts by donating
- 8 at retail outlets throughout North America; and
- 9 WHEREAS, All of these efforts culminate in inspirational,
- 10 memorable evening walks in nearly 200 communities each fall
- 11 across North America; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Nine communities across this Commonwealth, including
- 13 Erie, Wrightsville, Wayne, Pittsburgh, Center Valley, Johnstown,
- 14 Harrisburg, Doylestown and Philadelphia, have scheduled Light
- 15 the Night walks in September and October of this year; therefore
