A RESOLUTION

- Designating the month of August 2016 as "Pennsylvania Produce Month" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, This Commonwealth's vegetable industry generates
- 4 more than \$153 million in revenue to the economy of this
- 5 Commonwealth; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Three thousand nine hundred fifty farm families
- 7 manage approximately 49,400 acres that produce more than 280,000
- 8 tons of vegetables; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Vegetables are both delicious and nutritious,
- 10 providing important vitamins, fiber and other dietary components
- 11 that are essential to a healthy, balanced diet; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Health authorities have long encouraged increased
- 13 consumption of vegetables for good nutrition and disease
- 14 prevention; and

- 1 WHEREAS, Fresh Pennsylvania vegetables are available in
- 2 abundant supply and top quality at community farmers' markets,
- 3 roadside farm markets and supermarkets throughout this
- 4 Commonwealth; therefore be it
- 5 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the
- 6 month of August 2016 as "Pennsylvania Produce Month" in
- 7 Pennsylvania; and be it further
- 8 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize this
- 9 Commonwealth's abundant supply of "PA Preferred" fresh and
- 10 processed vegetable products and the industry's contributions to
- 11 the economy and health of this Commonwealth.
