A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing the month of October 2016 as "Domestic Violence 2 Awareness Month" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Domestic violence is a pattern of abusive behavior
- 4 used to establish power and control over an intimate partner;
- 5 and
- 6 WHEREAS, Domestic violence often causes emotional harm to
- 7 victims, their children, other family members, friends,
- 8 neighbors and coworkers; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Domestic violence affects men and women from all
- 10 racial, ethnic, religious, educational, social and economic
- 11 backgrounds; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Domestic violence takes many forms, whereby victims

- 1 are often subjected to abuse, harassment, threats, vandalism,
- 2 trespassing, burglary, theft and stalking; and
- 3 WHEREAS, Domestic violence often escalates, causing victims
- 4 to suffer physical and emotional trauma, anxiety, stress, sleep
- 5 deprivation, loss of confidence, fear and in some cases, injury
- 6 and death by suicide or homicide; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Domestic violence is one of the most chronically
- 8 underreported crimes; and
- 9 WHEREAS, There are many barriers to detecting domestic
- 10 violence; and
- 11 WHEREAS, One in every four women and one in every nine men
- 12 will experience domestic violence in his or her lifetime; and
- 13 WHEREAS, One in six women and 1 in 33 men have experienced an
- 14 attempted or completed rape; and
- WHEREAS, Approximately 1.3 million women and 835,000 men are
- 16 physically assaulted by an intimate partner annually in the
- 17 United States; and
- 18 WHEREAS, Thirty to sixty percent of perpetrators of intimate
- 19 partner violence also abuse children in the home; and
- 20 WHEREAS, Intimate partner violence results in more than 18.5
- 21 million mental health care visits each year; and
- 22 WHEREAS, The cost of intimate partner violence exceeds \$5.8
- 23 billion each year, \$4.1 billion of which is for direct medical
- 24 and mental health services; and
- 25 WHEREAS, Less than 20% of victims who report an injury from
- 26 intimate partner violence seek medical treatment following the
- 27 injury; and
- 28 WHEREAS, Children who witness domestic violence in their
- 29 homes are 74% more likely to commit criminal assaults as adults;
- 30 and

- 1 WHEREAS, Collectively, victims of domestic violence lose
- 2 almost 8 million days of paid work annually as a result of the
- 3 violence; and
- WHEREAS, Each year, businesses forfeit about \$100 million in
- 5 lost wages, sick leave, absenteeism and nonproductivity; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Only about 20% of those who experience intimate
- 7 partner violence obtain protection from abuse orders; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Each year, domestic violence programs in this
- 9 Commonwealth provide services to approximately 95,000 victims of
- 10 domestic violence; and
- 11 WHEREAS, To increase victims' safety, authorities must
- 12 carefully follow screening, reporting, documentation and
- 13 referral requirements; and
- 14 WHEREAS, At-risk individuals and families need victim
- 15 education relating to their legal rights, judicial proceedings,
- 16 advocacy, counseling and support services, shelter care and
- 17 crisis intervention; therefore be it
- 18 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the
- 19 month of October 2016 as "Domestic Violence Awareness Month" in
- 20 Pennsylvania.
