A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the Commonwealth's ambassador for the White House
2 Initiative on Historically Black Colleges and Universities.

3 WHEREAS, Anitra Jackson was awarded a full merit scholarship
4 to attend the nation's first historically black university,
5 Cheyney University of Pennsylvania; and

6 WHEREAS, Anitra Jackson is a student with a double major in
7 computer science and mathematics, and she participated as a
8 member of the track and field, tennis and cross country teams;

10 WHEREAS, Anitra Jackson is a member of the Alpha Lambda Delta
11 Honor Society, the Keystone Honors Council and the Student
12 Academic Council and an executive board member of the National
13 Society of Leadership and Success; and

14 WHEREAS, Anitra Jackson was crowned Miss Cheyney 2016; and

15 WHEREAS, Anitra Jackson is the only college student in this
16 Commonwealth to serve as an ambassador for the White House

1 Initiative on Historically Black Colleges and Universities and
2 has attained distinction as a 2016 Historically Black Colleges
3 and Universities All-Star; therefore be it

5 Commonwealth's ambassador for the White House Initiative on
6 Historically Black Colleges and Universities.
