## AN ACT

1 2 3 4	Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in registration of vehicles, providing for multiple-war veteran plate; and, in fees, further providing for exemption of persons, entities and vehicles from fees.	
5	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania	
6	hereby enacts as follows:	
7	Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated	
8	Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:	
9	<u>§ 1369.3. Multiple-war veteran plate.</u>	
10	Upon application of any person who is a veteran of all of the	
11	following wars: World War II, the Korean War and the Vietnam	
12	Conflict, accompanied by a fee of \$20 and by such documentation	
13	as the department shall require, the department shall issue to	
14	such person a special registration plate designating the vehicle	
15	so registered as belonging to a person who is a veteran of all	
16	of those three wars. The special registration plate may be used	
17	only on one passenger vehicle or one other vehicle with a gross	
18	weight of not more than 9,000 14,000 pounds. <-
