1 2 3 4	Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in miscellaneous provisions, further providing for snow and ice dislodged or falling from certain moving vehicles.
5	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6	hereby enacts as follows:
7	Section 1. Section 3720 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
8	Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
9	§ 3720. Snow and ice [dislodged or falling from moving
10	vehicle].
11	<u>(a) Duty to remove</u>
12	(1) A driver of a motor vehicle with a registered gross
13	weight exceeding 48,000 pounds that is a truck tractor or
14	combination being operated on a street or highway of this
15	Commonwealth has an affirmative duty to make all reasonable
16	efforts to remove all accumulated ice or snow from the motor
17	vehicle, including the roof of the truck trailer or a vehicle
18	in the combination.
19	(2) A driver of a motor vehicle who violates this

1	subsection may be stopped on a street or highway by a law
2	enforcement officer if the law enforcement officer believes
3	the accumulated ice or snow may pose a threat to persons or
4	property.
5	(3) A person who violates this subsection shall be
6	<u>subject to a fine of not less than \$25 nor more than \$75 for</u>
7	each offense regardless of whether any snow or ice is
8	dislodged from the vehicle.
9	(b) Dislodged or fallen snow or iceWhen snow or ice is
10	dislodged or falls from a moving vehicle and strikes another
11	vehicle or pedestrian causing death or serious bodily injury,
12	the operator of the vehicle from which the snow or ice is
13	dislodged or falls shall be subject to a fine of not less than
14	\$200 nor more than [\$1,000] <u>\$1,500</u> for each offense.
15	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
