## AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain 2 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial 3 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," in terms and courses of study, providing for historical documents, writings and records use 6 in classrooms and censorship prohibited. 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 10 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a 11 12 section to read: 13 Section 1515.1. Historical Documents, Writings and Records 14 Use in Classrooms and Censorship Prohibited. -- (a) No teacher or administrator in a public school entity shall be prohibited from 15 using or reading from, during the course of educational 16 17 instruction, or posting in a public school building, classroom or event any of the following or any excerpts or portions of the 18

- 12 <u>(ix) Acts of the Congress of the United States and acts of</u>
- 13 <u>the Pennsylvania General Assembly.</u>
- 14 (x) Organic documents from the pre-Colonial, Colonial,
- 15 Revolutionary, Federalist and post-Federalist eras.
- 16 (b) The use, reading or posting of the types of documents,
- 17 writings and records authorized by this section shall be
- 18 undertaken for educational purposes only and shall not be used,
- 19 read from or posted to promote or establish any religion or
- 20 religious belief.
- 21 (c) No person may impose content-based censorship of an
- 22 American or Pennsylvania historical document, writing or record
- 23 <u>based on any religious references contained in such document,</u>
- 24 writing or record.
- 25 (d) The Department of Education shall immediately distribute
- 26 a copy of this section to all school districts, and they shall
- 27 then notify all public school teachers of the provisions of this
- 28 section.
- 29 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
