AN ACT

- 1 Establishing the Youth Job Program; providing for job training
- and career experience to unemployed youths; imposing powers
- and duties on the Department of Conservation and Natural
- 4 Resources; and making an appropriation.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Short title.
- 8 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Youth Job
- 9 Program Act.
- 10 Section 2. Definitions.
- 11 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 12 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 13 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 14 "Department." The Department of Conservation and Natural
- 15 Resources of the Commonwealth.
- "Local government." A municipality as defined in 1 Pa.C.S. §
- 17 1991 (relating to definitions).
- 18 "Program." The Youth Job Program established by this act.

- 1 "Qualified youth." Individuals who are between 16 and 21
- 2 years of age and who are unemployed or who have never been
- 3 employed.
- 4 "TANF." The Temporary Assistance for Needy Families program
- 5 under the Social Security Act (49 Stat. 620, 42 U.S.C. § 301 et
- 6 seq.).
- 7 Section 3. Youth Job Program.
- 8 (a) Establishment.--The Youth Job Program is established
- 9 within the department.
- 10 (b) Purpose. -- The purpose of the program is to provide
- 11 valuable job training and career experience to unemployed youth
- 12 throughout this Commonwealth by providing summer employment
- 13 opportunities at State and local parks and recreation facilities
- 14 to qualified youth. Employment opportunities shall be offered
- 15 either through the department or through local governments that
- 16 receive grant funding under this act.
- 17 (c) Program requirements.--
- 18 (1) Qualified youth may be employed by the department or
- a local government at an hourly rate of \$10 per hour. The
- 20 receipt of a salary or other benefits by the qualified youth
- 21 under this program shall not be used in calculating income
- for purposes of determining eligibility for TANF benefits by
- the qualified youth's parents or legal guardians.
- 24 (2) Qualified youth employed by the department or a
- local government under the program shall be limited to a
- 26 maximum of 25 employment hours per week.
- 27 (3) The period of employment offered to qualified youth
- by the department or a local government under the program
- shall not exceed 10 weeks.
- 30 Section 4. Powers and duties of department.

- 1 The department shall have the following powers and duties:
- 2 (1) To employ qualified youth with the department for
- 3 purposes of carrying out the provisions of this act.
- 4 (2) To establish application procedures for local
- 5 governments to apply for grants to carry out the purposes of
- 6 this act.
- 7 (3) To establish a procedure for awarding grants to
- 8 local governments, except that no grant may be awarded to a
- 9 local government whose proposed program does not comply with
- 10 section 3(c).
- 11 Section 5. Appropriation.
- The sum of \$25,000,000 is hereby appropriated from the Oil
- 13 and Gas Lease Fund to the department for the purposes of this
- 14 act.
- 15 Section 6. Effective date.
- 16 This act shall take effect immediately.
