- Amending the act of April 16, 1992 (P.L.155, No.28), entitled "An act providing for the certification and recertification 2 of assessors; establishing eligibility and training 3 requirements; defining the powers and duties of the State Board of Certified Real Estate Appraisers relating to 5 training, certification and recertification of assessors; and authorizing the board to establish fees," further providing for nonapplicability; and providing for assessors in counties 8 of the first class. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 10 11 hereby enacts as follows: 12 Section 1. Section 11 of the act of April 16, 1992 (P.L.155, 13 No.28), known as the Assessors Certification Act, amended 14 November 19, 2004 (P.L.834, No.100), is repealed: 15 [Section 11. Nonapplicability. 16 This act shall not apply to counties of the first class.] 17 Section 2. The act is amended by adding a section to read: 18 Section 11.1. Assessors in counties of the first class. 19 An assessor who is employed by a county of the first class on
