AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
 2 Statutes, in registration of vehicles, providing for special
 3 plates for active members of the armed forces of the United
 4 States.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
 6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
 8 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:

9 § 1364.1. Special plates for active members of the armed forces
 10 of the United States.

11 Upon application of any person who is currently serving as an
 12 active member of the armed forces of the United States or a
 13 reserve component of the armed forces or an active member of the
 14 Pennsylvania National Guard, within the meaning of 51 Pa.C.S.
 15 (relating to military affairs), accompanied by a fee of \$20
 16 which shall be in addition to the annual registration fee and by
 17 such documentation as the department shall require, the
 18 department shall issue to the person a special registration

1 plate designating the vehicle as belonging to a person who is an
2 active member of the armed forces of the United States. The
3 special registration plate may be used only on a passenger car
4 or truck with a registered gross weight of not more than 14,000
5 pounds.

6 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
