## AN ACT

- Amending the act of July 28, 1953 (P.L.723, No.230), entitled, as amended, "An act relating to counties of the second class 2 and second class A; amending, revising, consolidating and 3 changing the laws relating thereto, " in county commissioners 4 and chief clerk, further providing for vacancy in the office 5 of county commissioner. 6 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 8 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Section 501 of the act of July 28, 1953 (P.L.723, 9 No.230), known as the Second Class County Code, is amended to 10 11 read: 12 Section 501. Election[; Vacancies].--[(a)] Three county 13 commissioners shall be elected in the county in the year one 14 thousand nine hundred and fifty-five and every fourth year thereafter. In the election of commissioners, each qualified 15 16 elector shall vote for no more than two persons. The three
- 18 [(b) Any vacancy in the office of county commissioners shall

persons having the highest number of votes shall be elected.

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- 19 be filled for the balance of the unexpired term by the court of
- 20 common pleas of the county, by the appointment of an elector of

- 1 the county who voted for the commissioner whose place is to be
- 2 filled.]
- 3 Section 2. The act is amended by adding a section to read:
- 4 <u>Section 501.1. Vacancies.--(a) If a vacancy occurs in the</u>
- 5 office of county commissioner by death, resignation, removal
- 6 from the county or by failure to take the required oath or to
- 7 give bond as provided by law or ordinance, or in another manner,
- 8 the following shall apply:
- 9 (1) The two remaining commissioners shall direct the chief
- 10 clerk to request that the county committee of the political
- 11 party or political body of the vacated commissioner at the time
- 12 the vacated commissioner was elected submit a list of three
- 13 <u>names to be chosen through a conference process or another</u>
- 14 process as provided in the bylaws of the political party or
- 15 political body. The committee shall submit the names within
- 16 thirty (30) days of the vacancy and may rank them in order of
- 17 preference. The names provided in accordance with this paragraph
- 18 shall constitute the exclusive candidates for appointment to
- 19 fill the vacancy by the two remaining commissioners, the vacancy
- 20 board and the court. As used in this paragraph, the terms
- 21 "political party" or "political body" shall have the meanings
- 22 given to them in section 801 of the act of June 3, 1937
- 23 (P.L.1333, No.320), known as the "Pennsylvania Election Code."
- 24 (2) The two remaining county commissioners shall appoint a
- 25 <u>successor within forty-five (45) days after the vacancy occurs.</u>
- 26 If the two remaining county commissioners fail to make the
- 27 <u>appointment within forty-five (45) days, the appointment shall</u>
- 28 be made by the vacancy board within fifteen (15) days after the
- 29 <u>expiration of the forty-five (45) day period. The vacancy board</u>
- 30 shall consist of the two remaining county commissioners and the

- 1 one elector of the county, who shall be appointed by the county
- 2 commissioners at the board's first meeting each calendar year or
- 3 as soon after that is practical and who shall act as chairperson
- 4 of the vacancy board. If the vacancy board fails to fill the
- 5 position within fifteen (15) days after the expiration of the
- 6 <u>forty-five (45) day period</u>, the chairperson or, if there is a
- 7 vacancy in the position of chairperson, the remaining members of
- 8 the vacancy board shall petition the court of common pleas to
- 9 <u>fill the vacancy.</u>
- 10 (3) If two or more vacancies exist in the office of county
- 11 commissioner, the court of common pleas shall fill the vacancies
- 12 upon presentation of a petition signed by not less than fifteen
- 13 electors of the county. Upon receipt of the petition, the court
- 14 shall request names from the appropriate county committee as
- 15 provided under paragraph (1).
- (b) If a county committee has not provided names in
- 17 accordance with subsection (a), or if the commissioner whose
- 18 office is vacant is not a member of a political party or a
- 19 political body, a successor qualified under subsection (c) may
- 20 be appointed to fill the vacancy.
- 21 (c) A successor appointed to fill a vacancy in accordance
- 22 with this section shall:
- 23 (1) Be at least eighteen years of age, a citizen of the
- 24 United States and a resident of the county.
- 25 (2) Have resided within the county for one year next
- 26 preceding the successor's appointment.
- 27 (3) Be a registered elector of the county and a member of
- 28 the same political party or political body as the commissioner
- 29 whose place is to be filled at the time the commissioner was
- 30 elected. If the commissioner vacating office was independent of

- 1 <u>a political affiliation or was affiliated with a political</u>
- 2 organization other than a political party or political body, the
- 3 <u>successor shall be of the same affiliation if an available</u>
- 4 <u>candidate</u> is otherwise qualified under this subsection.
- 5 (4) Hold the office for the balance of the unexpired term.
- 6 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
