## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 23 (Domestic Relations) of the Pennsylvania
- Consolidated Statutes, in support matters generally, further
- 3 providing for attachment of income.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 4348(j) of Title 23 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 4348. Attachment of income.
- 9 \* \* \*
- 10 (j) Effect of compliance by employer. -- Compliance by an
- 11 employer with an order of attachment of income that is regular
- 12 on its face operates as a discharge of the civil liability of
- 13 the employer to the obligor as to that portion of the employment
- 14 income of the obligor affected. An employer shall not be subject
- 15 to criminal or civil liability to any individual or agency for
- 16 conduct in compliance with the order. The employer may deduct
- 17 from the income of the obligor [2% of the amount paid under the
- 18 order] a one-time fee of \$50 for reimbursement of the expense in

- 1 complying with the order. In no case shall the employer's
- 2 reimbursement be deducted from the amount of the support order.

- 4 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
