## AN ACT

Amending the act of March 4, 1971 (P.L.6, No.2), entitled "An act relating to tax reform and State taxation by codifying and enumerating certain subjects of taxation and imposing 3 taxes thereon; providing procedures for the payment, 4 collection, administration and enforcement thereof; providing for tax credits in certain cases; conferring powers and 7 imposing duties upon the Department of Revenue, certain employers, fiduciaries, individuals, persons, corporations 8 and other entities; prescribing crimes, offenses and 9 penalties," in personal income tax, providing for 10 contributions for State Food Purchase Program. 11 12 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 13 14 Section 1. The act of March 4, 1971 (P.L.6, No.2), known as 15 the Tax Reform Code of 1971, is amended by adding a section to 16 read: 17 Section 315.12. Contributions for State Food Purchase 18 Program. -- (a) The department shall provide a space on the 19 Pennsylvania individual income tax return form by which an individual may voluntarily designate a contribution of any 20 21 amount desired to the State Food Purchase Program established

under the act of December 11, 1992 (P.L.807, No.129), known as

- 1 the "State Food Purchase Program Act."
- 2 (b) The amount designated under subsection (a) by an
- 3 <u>individual on the income tax return form shall be deducted from</u>
- 4 the tax refund to which the individual is entitled and shall not
- 5 constitute a charge against the income tax revenues due the
- 6 <u>Commonwealth</u>.
- 7 (c) The department shall determine annually the total amount
- 8 <u>designated under this section</u>, <u>less reasonable administrative</u>
- 9 costs, and shall report the amount to the State Treasurer, who
- 10 shall transfer the amount from the General Fund to a restricted
- 11 account in the State Treasury to be used exclusively by the
- 12 <u>Department of Agriculture for the State Food Purchase Program.</u>
- 13 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
